A. Because of what has been previously revealed about Him “therefore”

B. Because of who we are in Christ

1. Holy Brethren

2. Partakers of a heavenly calling

II. WHAT ARE WE TO CONSIDER ABOUT JESUS? He is faithful! (1b-6a)

A. He is the faithful Apostle and High Priest of our confession (1b)

B. He is the faithful Builder of His own house (2-6A)

1. Moses was part of the house, but Jesus is the builder, (3-4)

2. Moses was a servant but Christ was a Son (5-6)

III. CONSIDER YOUR OWN WAYS: Is His faithfulness exhibited in your life? (6b)
