

# VBF Study in Revelation

## Lesson 46 Revelation 14:6-7

As you read through Revelation and begin this study, ask God to open your heart. As the Psalmist prayed; "Open my eyes, that I may behold Wonderful things from Thy law" (Psalm 119:18).

**Assignment:** Read through Revelation chapter 14. Attempt to answer the following discussion questions from the text alone.

### Questions:

1. Review: Read through chapters 12 and 13 again. Who is being introduced in these chapters? Who are the ones being introduced, being introduced in relationship to?
2. Review: What is going on in 14:1-5 and how does it relate to the previous two chapters in the context of Revelation?
3. What did John see in 14:6?

**PLEASE NOTE** As we look at Revelation, we see the term "Gospel" (used only here in Rev). With this in mind it is crucial to understand what the Gospel is. Therefore, we will take a diversion this week to hopefully gain a better understanding of the gospel.

4. Make observations from the following verses concerning the Gospel:

8. What will happen to those who do not believe or “obey” the true gospel? See (2Thes. 1:8, 1Peter 4:17) Does this concern you?
  
9. Is there just one gospel out there? Explain (See Gal. 1:6-10, 2Cor. 11:2-4)
  
- Note:* This is the first usage of this Greek term translated “judgment” here in Revelation so far
10. Looking at Revelation 14:7, make observations concerning the Gospel proclamation of the angel.
  
11. Do you think those who “live on the earth” understood who specifically was the one described in the phrase “the hour of His judgment has come (14:6)?” How might 6:16-17 help?
  
12. What did those in Revelation 16:9 not do and how does this relate to 14:7? What would be an evidence of true repentance? Has such evidence manifested in your life?
  
13. Besides fearing God and giving Him glory, what else are they commanded to do in 14:7b?
  
14. How does what is spoken of in 14:7 relate to the “eternal Gospel” (14:6)?
  
15. How does this angel's Gospel proclamation relate to what you've learned earlier concerning the Gospel? Have you ever declared to anyone that they need to fear God give, Him glory and worship Him? Has this ever been threaded into the rest of your understanding of the gospel?
  
16. Why is this angel's gospel message so urgent? Do you have a sense of urgency concerning the fate of those who don't know Christ?
  
17. Do the following verses describe you? (Rev. 19:5, Philippians 3:3) Do you fear God, give Him glory and worship Him? Explain.
