## A WARNING TO NOT GET TAKEN SPIRITUALLY CAPTIVE AVOIDING THREATS TO THE ABSOLUTE SUFFICIENCY OF CHRIST Colossians 2:8

- I. Watch Out ...LEST SOMEONE DECEPTIVELY TAKE YOU AWAY FROM CHRIST: Paul warns the Colossians to not let someone take them captive through philosophy and empty deception rather than Christ (8)
  - A. Be Alert and do not let persuasively deceptive and deceitful people who appear humble and spiritual, take you captive (8a)
  - B. How will they try to deceive and delude you into spiritual captivity? (8b)
    - 1. They will do so **through philosophy and empty deception** (in the context of persuasive arguments that delude) (8b, 4)
      - a) Their empty, deceitful philosophy is based on the traditions of man (8b)
      - b) **Their empty, deceitful philosophy** is based on the elementary principles of the world (8b)
    - 2. They do so in opposition to genuine daily faith in Christ, in whom are all the treasures of wisdom ad knowledge: Faith in Him and His truth Start to finish (8b)
