WORSHIP THE LORD!!! A WONDERFUL COMMAND AND A FRIGHTENING ULTIMATUM Prep for Nehemiah 12 PSALM 95

- I. WE WHO CLAIM TO BE GOD'S PEOPLE ARE COMMANDED TO JOYFULLY WORSHIP THE LORD TOGETHER (1-7a)
 - A. **The wonderful command** for us to come and joyfully worship the Lord who saved us (1-2)
 - B. The reason for our worship: He is a great God and King who made all things (3-4)
 - C. The command thus to worship and bow down (5-6)
 - D. **The reason for our worship:** Because of the Great Shepherd, He is our God and we are His people, His sheep (7a)
- II. THE ULTIMATUM for those who claim to be His people but are not: We must WORSHIP from a changed heart OR We will PERISH because of a hardened heart (7b-11)
 - A. If you hear His voice, do not let your heart harden (7b-8a)
 - B. The example of Israel's disobedience in the wilderness (8b-10)
 - 1. They hardened their hearts and tested the Lord, even though they had seen His might work (8-9)
 - 2. Therefore, God hated that generation, who errored in their hearts and did not know His way (10)
 - C. THEREFORE, GOD SWORE IN HIS ANGER THEY WOULD NOT ENTER HIS REST (Be saved from their sins) (11)

HOW IS THE CHURCH TO WORSHIP? PRINCIPLES OF CORPORATE WORSHIP REVEALED in THE DEDICATION OF THE WALL: Part 1 Nehemiah 12:1-39

- I. GIFTED PEOPLE ARE IDENTIFIED TO SERVE: Nehemiah gives a list of those who previously served and led in the worship of the Living God (1-26)
- **II.** THE WORSHIP SERVICE MUST BE PLANNED and thus servants sought: The Levites singers are sought out to celebrate with gladness, hymns of thanksgiving, and accompanied song and they assemble (27-29)
- **III. THE SERVANTS, PEOPLE AND PLACE ARE TO BE PURE:** The priest and Levites purified themselves, the people, the gates, and the wall (30)
- **IV. THE WORSHIP SERVICE IS TO BE ORGANIZED:** Nehemiah organized the leaders and two great choirs, and they proceeded on the wall to the house of God (32-39)

- V. THE WORSHIP SERVICE IS TO BE IMMERSED IN GLORIFYING MUSIC AND SINGING: The singers sang in the house of God (40-42, 27-28, 31, 35,36, 40)
- VI. THE WORSHIP SERVICE MUST BE FOCUSED ON CHRIST and HIS SACRIFICE which brings joy: On that day they offered joyous sacrifices (43)
- VII. THE WORSHIP SERVICE WILL INCLUDE WORSHIPFUL OFFERING: On that day the people worshiped, offering joyous offerings of tithes (44-47)
- VIII. THE WORSHIP SERVICE WILL HAVE CONVICTING PREACHING FROM THE WORD which elicits a righteous response: On that day the Word was read, and the people were convicted and responded in obedience concerning foreigners (13:1-3)
